Question 1:

Are you aware that the 1% Jefferson County Sales Tax revenues recently released to Hoover City Schools are restricted by the county for use only on capital projects, debt reduction and technology use?

Yes 64%
No 36%

Question 2:

Do you feel that decisions on the use of these windfall revenues should be the sole decision of the Superintendent and School Board or a result of feedback from a public forum?

Superintendent and School Board 10%
Public Forum 21%
Both 69%

Question 3:

Please prioritize the areas you feel the money should be spent:

NOTES:

Adding technology capacity to classrooms, building a third high school, and debt reduction were all highly ranked and distinction between the three was narrow.

Building athletic facilities was ranked 8th in priority by 63% of respondents.
